Dr. Kristjansson is an Associate Professor of Public Health at West Virginia University and a Senior Researcher at the Icelandic Center for Social Research and Analysis at Reykjavik University. He earned his PhD in Social Medicine from the Karolinska Institute in Sweden in 2010, and was a post-doctoral fellow at Columbia University in New York City between 2010-2012. The central focus of his work is on the health, behavioral development and well-being of children and youth with particular attention to substance use prevention and community health promotion. During the last 15 years dr. Kristjansson has acquired support for his research from the European Research Council, the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and the National Institutes of Health. He has published over 70 peer-reviewed papers in scholarly journals within public health, health education, preventive medicine and multidisciplinary adolescent journals.
